FACTS

Night TaxiBuzz represents one third of all Connect2Wiltshire runs in the Devizes area on weekdays. It operates from 6.15 pm to 10.15pm.

Night TaxiBuzz can be booked up to 20 minutes before you travel to or from All Cannings, Allington, Alton Barnes, Alton Priors, Beechingstoke, Bishops Cannings, Coate, Etchilhampton, Hilcott, Honey Street, Horton, Lydeaway, Marden, Patney, Stanton St Bernard, Stert, Urchfont, Wedhampton, Woodborough, Wilsford and Pewsey station. C2W is wheel chair accessible. Adult fares start from £1.20.

The Night TaxiBuzz is reducing parking at Pewsey Station, improving people's quality of life, helps people get to college, youth clubs, and return from work or a late night shift.

Over 4,000 trips were made in Night TaxiBuzz last year AND it is growing week on week.

Wiltshire wants to save £187,000 from public transport this year.

Night TaxiBuzz costs £50,000. So this cut represents nearly 30% of Wiltshire's target cuts for the whole of the county.

Devizes Taxis are prepared to reduce the contract price by half. This is a hefty saving of £25,000 RIGHT NOW. BUT Wiltshire Council STILL wants to cut the Night TaxiBuzz.

The cost per passenger is £3.70 NOT the £10 claimed by Wiltshire Council. Included in the £3.70 is the expensive remote Call Centre which the TaxiBuzz doesn't use.

Wiltshire commissioned Kennet Passengers to review C2W services in the Devizes area.

The report shows how savings can be made WITHOUT wholesale removal of front line services. BUT the cuts were announced before the ink was dry.

Wiltshire Council are interested in these findings, have found £10,000 for Pewsey and Devizes for transport for young people but STILL want to cut the Night TaxiBuzz.

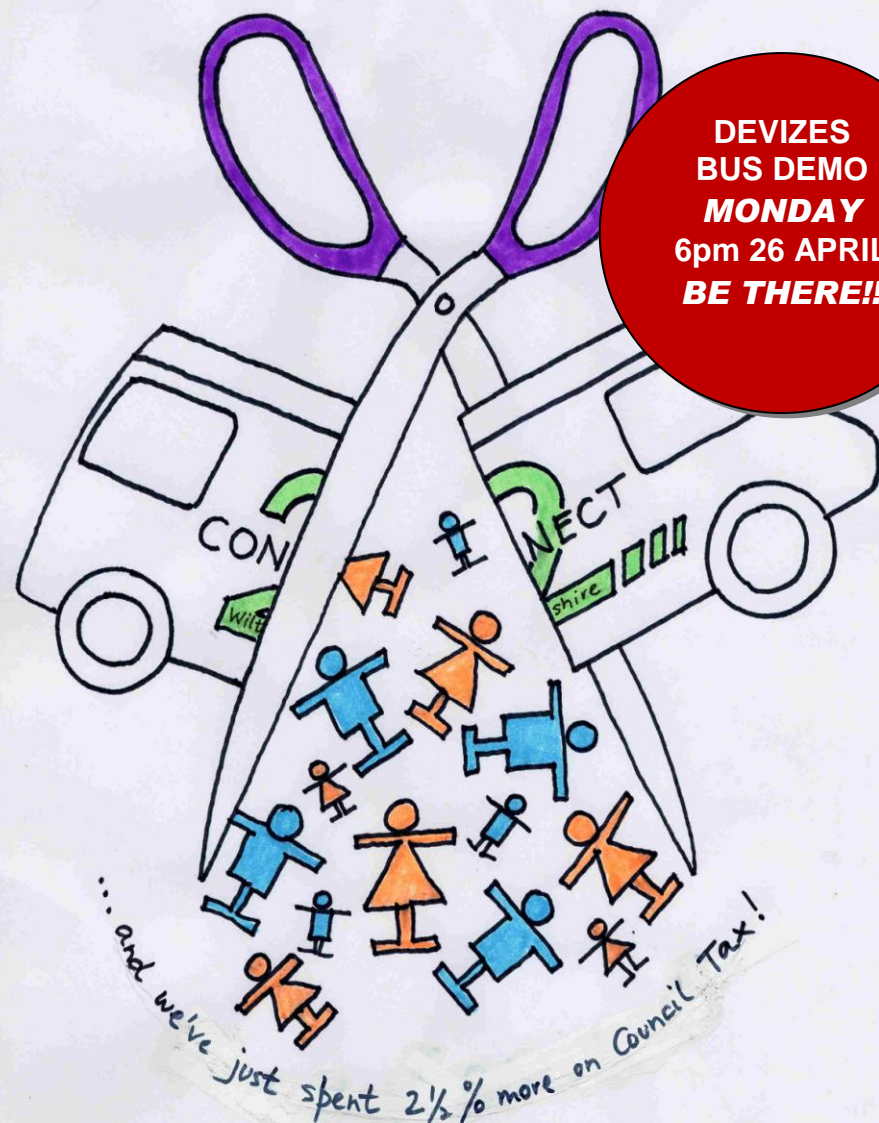
SO HOW WILL YOU MANAGE AFTER THE CUTS ON 28th MAY?
